Dr. L Rudy Broomes is affiliated with Us TOO Prostate Cancer International Education & Support Network, a 501(c) (3) charitable organization established in 1990 by prostate cancer survivors to serve fellow survivors and their families. UsTOO is dedicated to communicating timely and reliable information enabling informed

choices regarding detection and treatment of prostate cancer.

In addition to providing education and support programs, Us TOO is an active advocate for patients. It is committed to making sure patients have access to programs, medications, treatments, and health care professionals they need for the best possible outcomes.

During the fourth year (that began September 2006 and ended August 2007) of a five-year pilot program, Us TOO trained 21 facilitators and provided 6,246 individuals with information about the risk associated with prostate cancer, and the need for early detection in the state of Alabama. The network has a presence in 16 states and the District of Columbia and met all of its goals.

The goal for Alabama during the fifth year is to train an additional 20 facilitators and to contact 6,000 more individuals. Details of the UsTOO International Network may be found on www.ustoo.org.
